Greece has been chosen to be the first country to be featured, and the Cookery Committee along with the Hellenic Community Committee and the Castellorizian Association have decided to present 3 Classes as a representation of the Flavours of Greece.

- **Class 52 Kourabiedes (Shortbread)**

Six (6) pieces

- **Class 53 Baklava**

Six (6) diamond/triangle shapes suitable for afternoon tea

- **Class 54 Spanakopita (Spinach Pie)**

Page 31 of the schedule details the instructions for entering, including delivery of your entry on **Wednesday 25 September between 7:45am and 10:30am**. Stewards will greet you and help you present your entries on the standard white paper plates that are supplied. This allows for a complete blind tasting of all entries.

Entries will be judged by qualified Cookery Judges who have an expertise in the above classes, and who have been provided by The Castellorizian Association.

There is prize money and a prestigious Blue Ribbon to be won.

On **Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 of the Perth Royal Show**, there will be demonstrations in the **Cookery Pavilion 10.30am – 11.30am** and **1.00pm – 2.00pm** from some of our talented cooks who will be featuring items from "From Our GREEK KITCHEN to Yours". A reprint of this wonderful cooking book has been done so that the Flavours of Greece can be shared with the public.
